INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The fund seeks to provide long-term capital growth by investing primarily in U.S. common stocks.

The fund uses a disciplined portfolio construction process whereby it weights each sector approximately the same as the S&P 500 Index.

A team of industry-focused T. Rowe Price equity analysts is directly responsible for selecting stocks for the fund.

The fund seeks to add value via stock selection within each industry. It maintains style and sector exposures close to those of the S&P 500.

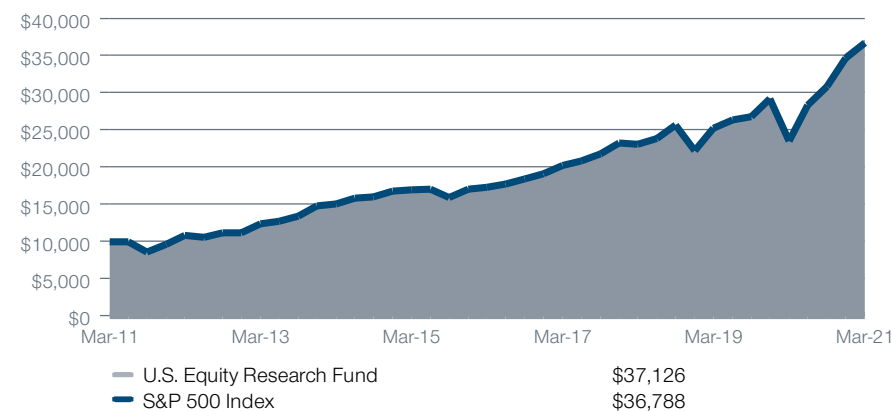
BENEFITS AND RISKS

Definitions

Beta: A measure of market risk of an investment option that shows how responsive the investment is to a given market index, such as the Standard & Poor's 500 Index. By definition, the beta of the benchmark is 1.00. An investment with a beta of 1.10 is expected to perform 10% better than the index in up markets and 10% worse in down markets. Usually, higher betas represent riskier investments. Figures are calculated using monthly data and are net of fees.

Morningstar rated the fund 4, 5, and 5 stars among 1,225, 1,068 and 809 Large Blend funds for the 3-, 5-, and 10-year periods (as applicable) ending 3/31/2021, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.
