Goal/Approach

The fund's eeks capital appreciation. The fund's investment strategy provides exposure to various mid cap equity portfolio managers, investment strategies and styles. The fund's investment adviser has allocated the fund's assets among multiple investment strategies employed by the fund's investment adviser and unaffiliated sub-investment advisers known as Boston Partners Global Investors Inc. (Boston Partners), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Robeco US Holding, Inc., and Henderson Geneva Capital Management LLC (Geneva). To pursue its goal, the fund normally invests at least 80% of its net assets, plus any borrowings for investment purposes, in equity securities of mid cap companies.




