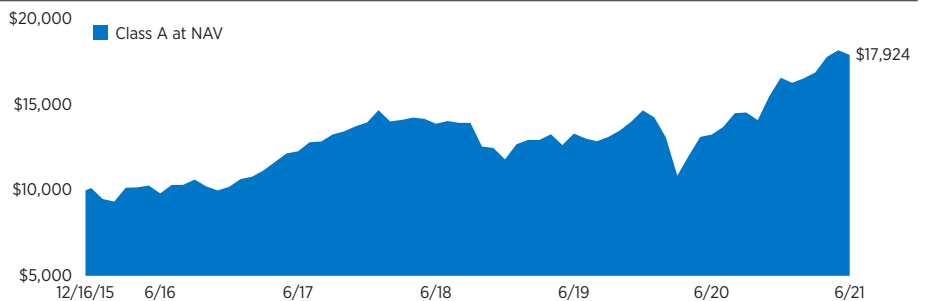
## The Approach

Stock selection is based primarily on a bottom-up process that identifies stocks through fundamental research. Management looks for companies well-positioned in an industry or niche benefiting from structural change, or companies with differentiated products or services that possess defensible barriers to entry, competitive advantages and scalable businesses.

## The Features

The Fund employs an investment process lead by an experienced portfolio manager with a focus on stock selection as the primary driver of alpha<sup>1</sup> generation. The Fund also provides both geographic and economic sector diversification<sup>2</sup> within a risk-managed framework, investing in foreign developed markets. The Fund may also invest in emerging countries.

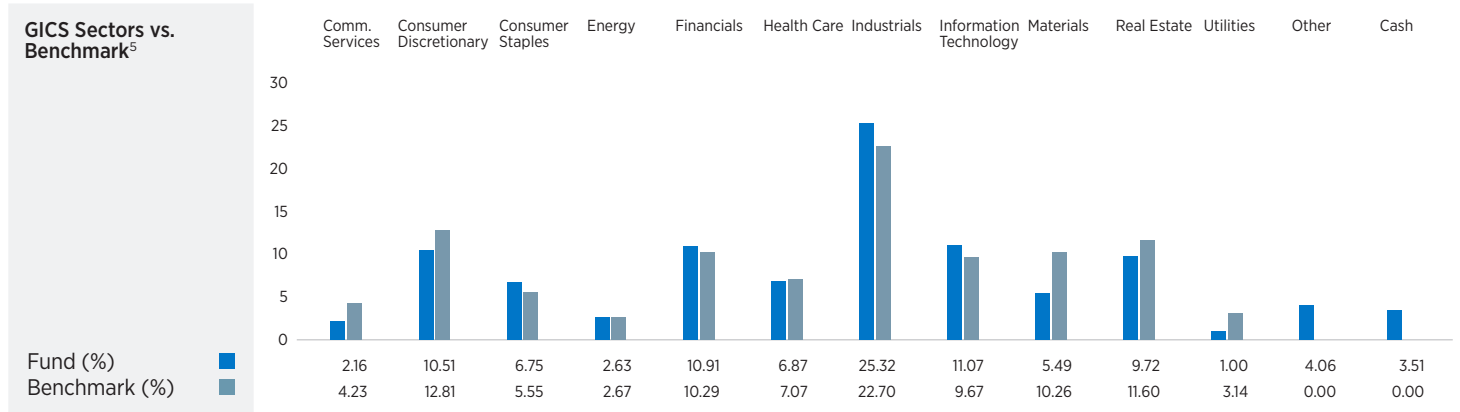
