Investment Objective and Strategy

The Fund seeks to provide long-term capital appreciation. The Fund invests in securities that the RS Value Team believes are undervalued. The Fund will typically invest most of its assets in equity securities of small-, mid-, or large-cap companies. The Fund may invest in securities of issuers located globally, and may invest any portion of its assets outside of the U.S. The Fund will likely hold a more limited number of securities than other mutual funds. The Fund's investment team conducts fundamental research to identify companies with improving returns on invested capital.

About the Fund

- Invest in small-, mid- and large-cap companies that are often considered outof-favor or misunderstood, with the view of delivering attractive risk-adjusted returns.
- Will likely hold a more limited number of securities than many other mutual funds.

The Morningstar Rating[™] for funds, or "star rating," is calculated for managed products (including mutual funds, variable annuity and variable life subaccounts, exchange-traded funds, closed- end funds, and separate accounts) with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The Morningstar Rating does not include any adjustment for sales loads. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star. The Overall Morningstar Rating for a managed product is derived from a weighted average of the performance figures associated with its three-, five-, and 10-year (if applicable)

Morningstar Rating metrics. The weights are: 100% three-year rating for 36-59 months of total returns, 60% five-year rating/40% three-year rating for 60-119 months of total returns, and 50% 10-year rating/30% five-year rating/20% three-year rating for 120 or more months of total returns. While the 10-year overall star rating formula seems to give the most weight to the 10-year period, the most recent three-year period actually has the greatest impact because it is included in all three rating periods. The Morningstar percentile ranking is based on a fund's average annual total returm (excluding sales charges) relative to all funds in the same category. The highest (most favorable) percentile rank is 1%, and the lowest (least favorable) percentile rank is 100%. Fund performance used for the rankings reflects certain fee waivers, without which, Morningstar rankings would have been lower and Morningstar ratings may have been lower.



Active Share is a measure that compares the proportion of security holdings within the product against those of the respective benchmark. The value represents the percentage difference between fund and benchmark. Market Capitalization is the total dollar value of all outstanding shares computed as number of shares times current market price. Alpha is the excess return of a fund relative to the return of a benchmark index. Beta is a measure of the volatility, or systematic risk, of a security or portfolio relative to the market or a benchmark. R-squared is

a statistical measure that represents the percentage of a fund's or security's movements that can be explained by movements in a benchmark index. **Information Ratio** is a measure of the value added per unit of active risk by a manager over the benchmark. **Sharpe Ratio** is the average return earned in excess of the risk-free rate per unit of volatility or total risk. **Portfolio Turnover Ratio – LTM** measures trading activity in a portfolio for the past year, indicating how often investments are bought and sold.

The Russell 3000[®] Value Index is a market-capitalization-weighted index that measures the performance of those companies in the Russell 3000[®] index with lower price-to-book ratios and lower forecasted growth values.

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
