INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The fund seeks long-term growth of capital by investing primarily in common stocks of small growth companies.

The fund will normally invest primarily in small-cap growth companies. The portfolio will be broadly diversified, and the top 25 holdings will not constitute a large portion of assets.

We employ a number of quantitative models developed by T. Rowe Price to identify stocks that could be included in the portfolio.

BENEFITS AND RISKS

The fund offers greater capital appreciation potential than large-company stocks.

The fund's broad diversification may make it less volatile than small-cap growth funds that have more concentrated portfolios.

Definitions

Beta: A measure of market risk of an investment option that shows how responsive the investment is to a given market index, such as the Standard & Poor's 500 Index. By definition, the beta of the benchmark is 1.00. An investment with a beta of 1.10 is expected to perform 10% better than the index in up markets and 10% worse in down markets. Usually, higher betas represent riskier investments. Figures are calculated using monthly data and are net of fees.

Additional Disclosures

Morningstar rated the fund 3, 3, and 3 stars among 576, 505 and 379 Small Growth funds for the 3-, 5-, and 10-year periods (as applicable) ending 6/30/2021, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.
