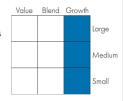
## Investment Principles

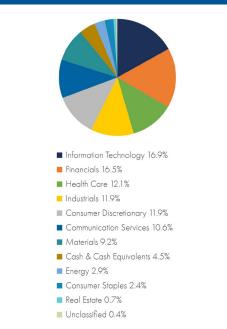

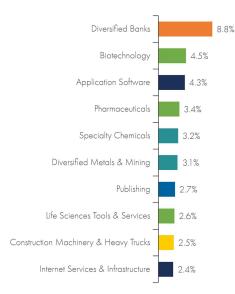
