About This Benchmark

The internet segment of the S&P TMI comprises the Internet and Direct Marketing Retail, Internet Services & Infrastructure and Interactive Media & Services sub-industry. The Index is one of twenty-one (21) of the S&P Select Industry Indices (the "Select Industry Indices"), each designed to measure the performance of a narrow subindustry or group of sub-industries determined based on the Global Industry Classification Standard ("GICS").

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Glossary

NAV The market value of a mutual fund's or ETFs total assets, minus liabilities, divided by the number of shares outstanding. Standardized Yield) An annualized yield that is calculated by dividing the net investment income earned by the fund over the most recent 30-day period by the current maximum offering price.

Est. 3-5 Year EPS Growth Based on the underlying holdings of the fund. The actual earnings estimates for the underlying holdings are provided by FactSet, First Call, I/B/E/S

Consensus, and Reuters and are used to calculate a mean 3-5 year EPS growth rate estimate.

Index Dividend Yield The weighted average of the underlyings' indicated annual dividend divided by price, expressed as a percentage. **Price/Earnings Ratio FY1** The weighted harmonic average of current share price divided by the forecasted one year earnings per share for each security in the fund. Negative and positive outliers are included in the calculation

Price/Book Ratio The weighted harmonic average of closing market price divided by the most recent reported book value for each security in the fund's portfolio as calculated for the last twelve months.
