Objective and strategy

Xtrackers MSCI Emerging Markets Hedged Equity ETF seeks investment results that correspond generally to the performance, before fees and expenses, of the MSCI Emerging Markets (EM) U.S. Dollar Hedged Index. The Index represents a close estimation of the performance that can be achieved by hedging the currency exposures of its parent index, the MSCI EM Index, to the USD, the "home" currency for the hedged index. The index is 100% hedged to the USD by selling each foreign currency forward at the one-month Forward weight. The parent index is composed of large and mid cap stocks across 23 Emerging Markets (EM) countries and its local performance is calculated in different currencies.

- ³ Dividend yield is a weighted-sum of the annualized dividends of the index components divided by the most recent index value. Annualized dividends are determined using a sum of all dividend announcements during the previous 12 months. Dividend yield is that of the MSCI EM Index and is the rate of income generated by a stock in the form of dividends. The dividend yield of the index should not be considered the dividend yield of the fund.


