## INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The fund seeks to provide long-term growth of capital.

The fund will normally invest at least 80% its net assets (including any borrowings for investment purposes) in securities issued by companies in the industrials sector. Under normal conditions, the fund invests in at least five different countries, including the U.S., and at least 40% of the fund's net assets will normally be invested in companies outside the U.S.

The fund seeks to invest in various companies engaged in the research, development, manufacture, distribution, supply or sale of industrial products, services, or equipment. The fund invests in a wide variety of industries within the industrials sector.


## **BENEFITS AND RISKS**

## Definitions

Beta: A measure of market risk of an investment option that shows how responsive the investment is to a given market index, such as the Standard & Poor's 500 Index. By definition, the beta of the benchmark is 1.00. An investment with a beta of 1.10 is expected to perform 10% better than the index in up markets and 10% worse in down markets. Usually, higher betas represent riskier investments. Figures are calculated using monthly data and are net of fees.

#### Additional Disclosures

Morningstar rated the fund 5 and 5 stars among 39 and 35 Industrials funds for the 3- and 5-year periods (as applicable) ending 9/30/2021, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% . receive 1 star.
