(predecessor to Manning & Napier Advisors, LLC), an affiliate of the distributor, and reorganized into the Manning & Napier Fund, Inc. Overseas Series on 07/10/2002. The Collective was not open to the public generally or registered under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and the fees of the Collective were lower than the Series' fees. Therefore, the historical performance of the Collective would have been lower if the Collective had been subject to the same fees as the Series.
