Objective: Long-term capital appreciation

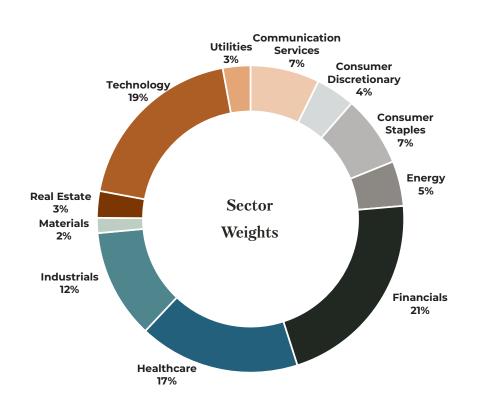
Framework:
