

# Calvert US Large-Cap Value Responsible Index Fund

## Fund Overview

The Fund seeks to track the performance of the Calvert US Large-Cap Value Responsible Index, which is composed of common stocks of large growth companies selected from the 1,000 largest publicly-traded U.S. companies based on market capitalization and value style factors. It offers broad exposure to companies that meet The Calvert Principles for Responsible Investment (Calvert Principles).

## Research Process

Calvert Research and Management conducts deep, proprietary research across approximately 200 peer groups using over 200 key performance indicators (KPIs) to measure material environmental, social, and governance (ESG) factors. The Calvert US Large-Cap Value Responsible Index has approximately 500 holdings that are reconstituted annually and are rebalanced quarterly.

The Calvert Principles provide a framework for considering ESG factors and guide Calvert's active engagement efforts with company management.

- **Uber Technologies:** Significant controversies related to passenger and driver safety
