Fund Overview

The Fund is designed to closely track the Calvert International Responsible Index, which is composed of common stocks of large companies in developed markets, excluding the U.S. It offers broad exposure to companies that meet The Calvert Principles for Responsible Investment (Calvert Principles).

Research Process

Calvert Research and Management conducts deep, proprietary research across approximately 200 peer groups using over 200 key performance indicators (KPIs) to measure material environmental, social, and governance (ESG) factors. The Calvert International Responsible Index has roughly 750 holdings that are reconstituted annually and are rebalanced quarterly.

Calvert Research and Management is a recognized leader in Responsible Investing, offering investment strategies that seek superior longterm performance and positive global impact. The Calvert Principles provide a framework for the evaluation of ESG factors and guide our active engagement efforts with company managements.
