Fund description

The Fund seeks a favorable long-term return, mainly through capital appreciation, primarily from equity securities. It normally invests at least 80% of its assets in large-cap equity securities that the management team believes present the opportunity for growth. "Large-cap" securities are securities of issuers with a capitalization equal to or greater than the top 80% of issuers by capitalization within the Russell 1000(R) Index at the time of purchase. The Fund's management team focuses on large capitalized companies in new and emerging areas of the economy and those with distinctive products or promising markets, and that have the potential, in the view of fund management, for strong earnings and/or sales growth. The Fund also seeks to invest in companies expected to benefit from prospective acquisitions, reorganizations or other special situations. It may invest up to 20% of its assets in foreign investments.

Glossary

Beta is a measure of the volatility of a portfolio relative to the overall market. A beta less than 1.0 indicates lower risk than the market, a beta greater than 1.0 indicates higher risk than the market. P/E ratio of a stock is calculated by dividing the current price of the stock by its forecasted 12 months' earnings per share. The average of the price/earnings ratio of a fund is a weighted harmonic average of all the current P/E ratios (excluding negatives) of the stocks in the Fund's portfolio. Standard deviation is a statistical measure of the historical volatility of a mutual fund or portfolio; the higher the number the greater the risk. Turnover ratio is calculated by dividing the lesser of purchases or sales by the average value of portfolio assets during a period. Weighted average market capitalization is the portfolio-weighted mean capitalizations of all equity securities.
