



Ratings are based on a risk-adjusted return measure that accounts for variation in a fund's monthly performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. Open-end mutual funds and exchange-traded funds are considered a single population for comparison purposes. Ratings are calculated for funds with at least a three year history. The overall rating is derived from a weighted average of three-, five- and 10year rating metrics, as applicable, excluding sales charges and including fees and expenses. Had fees not been waived and/or expenses reimbursed currently or in the past, the Morningstar rating would have been lower. Class A shares received 4 stars for the overall, 3 stars for the three years, 3 stars for the five years and 4 stars for the 10 years. The fund was rated among 139, 139, 105 and 70 funds within the Morningstar World Small/Mid Stock Category for the overall period, three, five and 10 years, respectively.
