

**Quantitative analysis**Screens for inexpensive stocks using multiple valuation measures, and seeking to identify companies at the lower end of their historical valuation ranges that offer what we consider attractive risk/reward characteristics.

Fundamental analysis
Conducts comprehensive
business reviews to develop a sound understanding of a company's business. Focuses on understanding the cause of a company's undervaluation and its ability to realize its valuation potential.

Portfolio management Constructs the Fund's final portfolio using a bottom-up approach to stock selection. Weighs a number of factors including fundamentals, timing of catalysts, and growth prospects.

The Fund acquired the assets and liabilities of the Chartwell Small Cap Value Fund (the "Predecessor Fund"), a series of Investment Managers Series Trust, on July 17, 2017. As a result of the reorganization, the Fund is the accounting successor of the Predecessor Fund. Performance results shown (prior to July 17, 2017) reflect the performance of the Predecessor Fund. The Fund's past performance is not necessarily an indication of how the Fund will perform in the future.
