

Parametric Tax-Managed International Equity Fund

Diversified international equity fund focused on after-tax returns.

The Fund

The Fund's rules-based, top-down process seeks to take advantage of certain quantitative and behavioral characteristics of developed international markets. Emphasis is placed on small- and mid-sized countries and economic sectors.

The Approach

We invest in countries by tilting the portfolio away from the highest concentrations in the market. The portfolio is rebalanced as concentrations build by seeking to sell into strength and buy into weakness.

The Features

The Fund seeks to capture gains through systematic rebalancing, while providing diversified exposure to developed markets outside the U.S. The Fund also seeks to maintain exposure across key economic sectors.

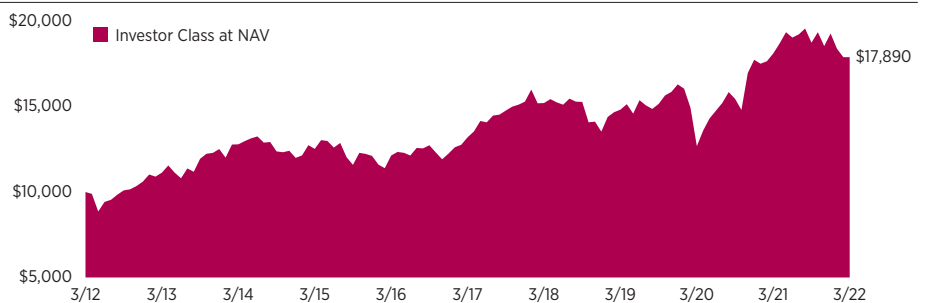

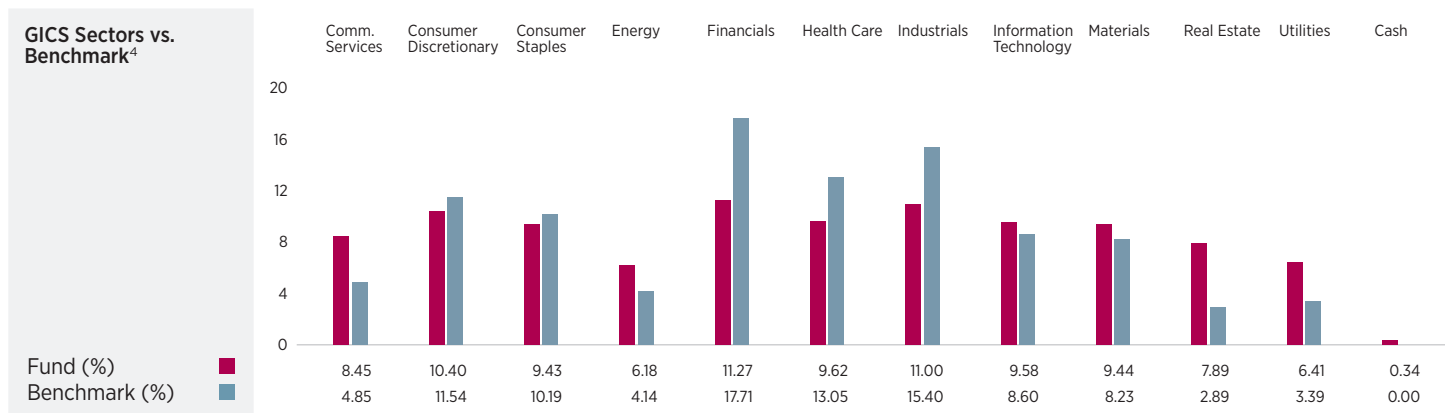

After-tax returns are calculated using certain assumptions, including using the highest individual federal income tax rates in effect at the time of the distributions and do not reflect the impact of state/local taxes. After-tax returns are not relevant to shareholders who hold shares in tax-deferred accounts or shares held by nontaxable entities. Return After Taxes on Distributions may be the same as Return Before Taxes for the same period because no taxable distributions were made during that period. Return After Taxes on Distributions and Sale of Fund Shares may be greater than or equal to Return After Taxes on Distributions for the same period because of losses realized on the sale of Fund shares. Before-tax and after-tax returns for other classes of shares offered by the Fund are different.

Effective April 29, 2022, Investor Class and Institutional Class shares of the Fund will be redesignated to Class A shares and Class I shares, respectively.
