

Invesco PureBeta FTSE Developed ex- North America ETF

Fund description

The Invesco PureBetaSM FTSE Developed ex-North America ETF (Fund) is based on the FTSE Developed ex North America Index (Index). The fund will invest at least 90% of its total assets in securities that comprise the index. The index measures the performance of large- and mid-capitalization developed markets outside of North America. The Index is computed using the net return, which withholds applicable taxes for non-resident investors. The fund and the index are rebalanced quarterly at the close of business on the third Friday of March, June, September and December.

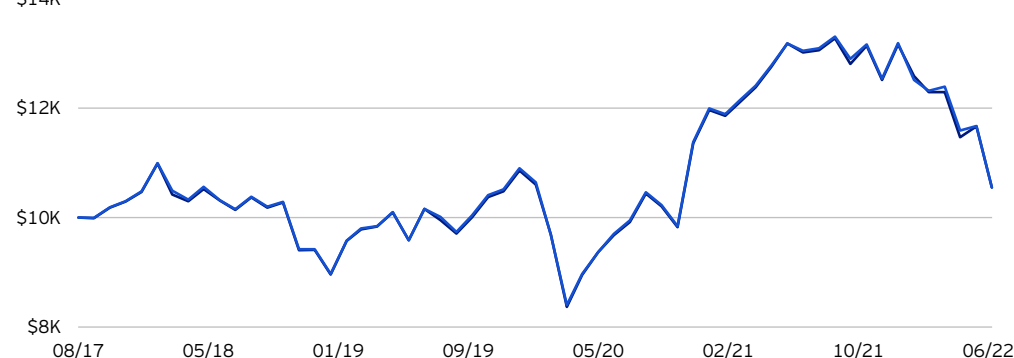

Glossary

30 Day SEC Unsubsidized Yield reflects the 30-day yield if the investment adviser were not waiving all or part of its fee or reimbursing the fund for part of its expenses. Total return would have also been lower in the absence of these temporary reimbursements or waivers.

30 Day SEC Yield is based on a 30-day period and is computed by dividing the net investment income per share earned during the period by the maximum offering price per share on the last day of the period.

Intraday NAV is a symbol representing estimated fair value based on the most recent intraday price of underlying assets.

Weighted Harmonic Average Stock Price-to-Book-Value Ratio (P/B Ratio) is the ratio of a stock's market price to a company's net asset value.

Weighted Harmonic Average Stock Price-to-Earnings Ratio (P/E Ratio) is the share price divided by earnings per share. It is measured on a 12-month trailing basis.

Weighted Average Return on Equity is net income divided by net worth.

Weighted Market Capitalization is the sum of each underlying securities market value.
