Russell 1000 Index measures the performance of the large-cap segment of the U.S. equity universe. IOPV, or Indicative Optimized Portfolio Value, is a calculation disseminated by the stock exchange that approximates the Fund's NAV every fifteen seconds throughout the trading day. Price/Earnings is the ratio of a stock's current price divided by the trailing earnings per share for the past 12 months. Price/Book is the ratio of a stock's price to its book value per share. Nominal Companies represents the total number of companies included in the portfolio, regardless of allocation. Effective Companies measures portfolio concentration, in which a higher number would indicate a more diversified portfolio. Debt-to-equity ratio measures a company's financial leverage calculated by dividing its total liabilities by stockholders' equity. Return on Equity is the average amount of net income after taxes that a firm is able to earn as a percent of stockholders equity. Index Dividend Yield is the weighted average dividend yield of the securities in the underlying portfolio index (including cash). The number is not intended to demonstrate income earned or distributions made by the Fund and is not necessarily indicative of the dividend yield of the Fund. Fundamental characteristics are based on industry-standard calculation methodologies and determined by Hartford Funds. Holdings may not sum to 100% due to cash allocations.
