INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The fund seeks long-term capital growth through investments in stocks.

- Ability to sustain earnings momentum even during economic slowdowns
- Occupation of a lucrative niche in the economy and ability to expand even during times of slow economic growth

BENEFITS AND RISKS

Our investment approach reflects our belief that solid company fundamentals combined with a positive industry outlook will ultimately reward investors with strong investment performance.

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Definitions

Beta: A measure of market risk of an investment option that shows how responsive the investment is to a given market index, such as the Standard & Poor's 500 Index. By definition, the beta of the benchmark is 1.00. An investment with a beta of 1.10 is expected to perform 10% better than the index in up markets and 10% worse in down markets. Usually, higher betas represent riskier investments. Figures are calculated using monthly data and are net of fees.

Additional Disclosures

Morningstar rated the fund 2, 2, and 3 stars among 1,142, 1,060 and 790 Large Growth funds for the 3-, 5-, and 10-year periods (as applicable) ending 9/30/2022, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.
