INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The fund seeks long-term growth of capital through investments in stocks of non-U.S. companies.

Focus on investing in stocks of companies located outside the U.S.

- At least 80% of its net asset in non-U.S. companies.
- No more than 15% of its net assets will be invested in stocks of companies in emerging markets.

Invests in about 60 to 70 different stocks although the number could vary depending on market condition.

The fund is "nondiversified" meaning it may invest a greater portion of assets in a single company.

Securities are chosen based on "bottom-up" research and country allocation is driven by stock selection.

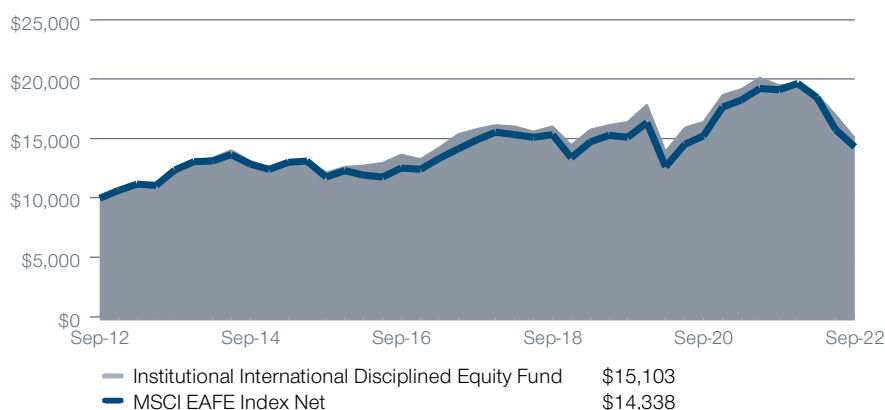

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Definitions

Beta: A measure of market risk of an investment option that shows how responsive the investment is to a given market index, such as the Standard & Poor's 500 Index. By definition, the beta of the benchmark is 1.00. An investment with a beta of 1.10 is expected to perform 10% better than the index in up markets and 10% worse in down markets. Usually, higher betas represent riskier investments. Figures are calculated using monthly data and are net of fees.

Additional Disclosures

Morningstar rated the fund 3, 3, and 4 stars among 701, 610 and 419 Foreign Large Blend funds for the 3-, 5-, and 10-year periods (as applicable) ending 9/30/2022, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.

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Unless otherwise noted, index returns are shown with gross dividends reinvested.
