#### **Fund description**

The Fund seeks a favorable long-term total return, mainly through capital appreciation. It normally invests at least 80% of its assets in small-cap and mid-cap equity securities. The Fund seeks to invest in companies across a wide range of sectors, growth rates and valuations. The Fund's management team seeks to add incremental returns over its stated benchmark index, while also managing the relative risk of the Fund versus its benchmark index. The Fund's management team uses proprietary quantitative models based on financial and investment theories to evaluate and score a broad universe of stocks in which the Fund invests. The Fund will invest primarily in securities within the capitalization range of companies included in the Russell  $2500^{\rm TM}$  Index.

The Morningstar Rating  $^{\mathbb{M}}$  for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for managed products (including mutual funds, variable annuity and variable life subaccounts, exchange-traded funds, closed-end funds, and separate accounts) with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star. The Overall Morningstar Rating for a managed product is derived from a weighted average of the performance figures associated with its three-, five-, and 10-year (if

applicable) Morningstar Rating metrics. The weights are: 100% three-year rating for 36-59 months of total returns, 60% five-year rating/240% three-year rating for 60-119 months of total returns, and 50% 10-year rating/30% five-year rating for 120 or more months of total returns. #### Glossary

Beta is a measure of the volatility of a portfolio relative to the overall market. A beta less than 1.0 indicates lower risk than the market, a beta greater than 1.0 indicates higher risk than the market. P/E ratio of a stock is calculated by dividing the current price of the stock by its forecasted 12 months' earnings per share. The average of the price/earnings ratio of a fund is a weighted harmonic average of all the current P/E ratios (excluding negatives) of the stocks in the Fund's portfolio. This should not be construed as a forecast of the Fund's performance. Standard deviation is a statistical measure of the historical volatility of a mutual fund or portfolio; the higher the number the greater the risk. Turnover ratio is calculated by dividing the lesser of purchases or sales by the average value of portfolio assets during a period. Turnover is based on the portfolio's fiscal year end and is not annualized if the reporting period covers less than 12 months. Weighted average market capitalization is the portfolio-weighted mean capitalizations of all equity securities.
