Fund description

The Invesco S&P MidCap 400® Equal Weight ETF (Fund) is based on the S&P MidCap 400® Equal Weight Index (Index). The Fund will invest at least 90% of its total assets in securities that comprise the Index. The Index equally weights mid-cap securities in the S&P MidCap 400® Index. The Fund and the Index are rebalanced guarterly.



Weighted Average Return on Equity is net income divided by net worth.

Weighted Market Capitalization is the sum of each underlying securities market value.
