Morningstar Developed Markets ex-US Factor Tilt Index measures the performance of stocks located in developed countries across the world (as defined by Morningstar, excluding the United States) with increased exposure to small-capitalization and value stocks.

MSCI World ex USA Investable Market Index captures large, mid and small cap representation across 22 of 23 Developed Markets (DM) countries excluding the United States.

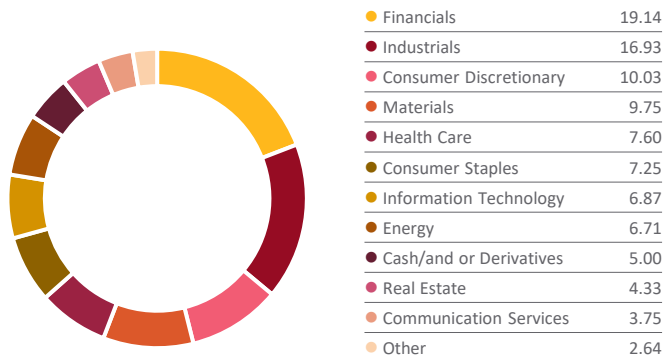

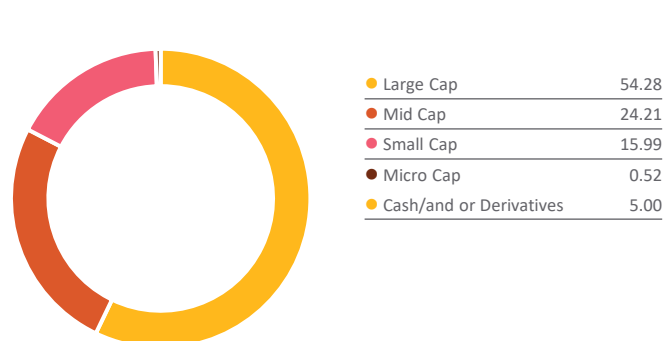

It is a "subsidized" yield, which means it includes contractual expense reimbursements and it would be lower without those reimbursements. It may also include an inflation adjustment that can cause the yield to vary substantially from one month to the next. The **30-Day SEC Unsubsidized Yield** calculation is also computed under the same SEC standardized formula based on net income earned over the past 30 days, but excludes contractual expense reimbursements, resulting in a lower yield. It may also include an inflation adjustment that can cause the yield to vary substantially from one month to the next.

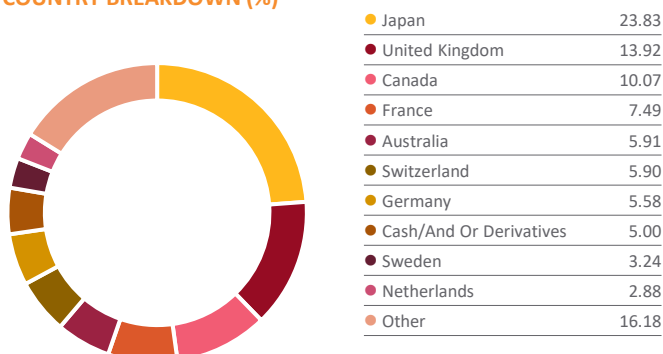
#### SECTOR BREAKDOWN (%)



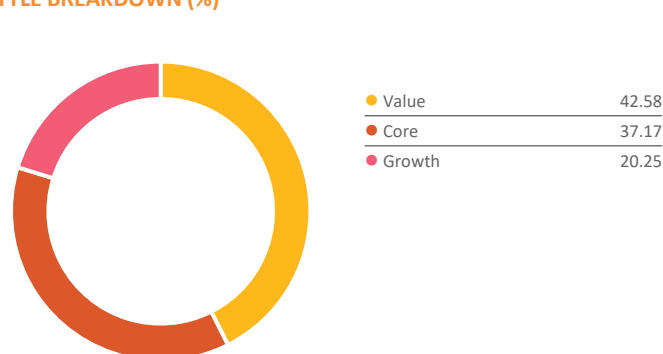
#### MARKET CAP BREAKDOWN (%)
