Since Inception returns for Class C shares for periods longer than 10 years reflect the performance of Class A shares after the deemed 10-year conversion to Class A shares within such periods. Class R6 shares have no sales charge and are available to certain qualified retirement plans and other investors as set forth in the statement of additional information. Glossary
