Fund description

The Invesco PureBetaSM US Aggregate Bond ETF (Fund) is based on the ICE BofAML US Broad Market IndexSM (Index). The fund will invest at least 80% of its total assets in securities that comprise the index. The index measures the performance of US dollar-denominated, investment grade debt securities, including US Treasury notes and bonds, quasi-government securities, corporate securities, residential and commercial mortgage-backed securities and assetbacked securities. Securities are cap-weighted based on their amount outstanding times the market price plus accrued interest. The Fund does not purchase all of the securities in the Index; instead, the Fund utilizes a "sampling" methodology to seek to achieve its investment objective. The fund and the index are rebalanced monthly on the last calendar day.

The Fund's final day of trading will occur on June 23, 2023. After market close on that date the Fund will no longer trade on an Exchange and will be subsequently delisted. The final distribution to shareholders of the Fund is expected to occur on or about June 30, 2023. Please see the Fund's prospectus for further information.



Glossary

30 Day SEC Unsubsidized Yield reflects the 30-day yield if the investment adviser were not waiving all or part of its fee or reimbursing the fund for part of its expenses. Total return would have also been lower in the absence of these temporary reimbursements or waivers.

30 Day SEC Yield is based on a 30-day period and is computed by dividing the net investment income per

share earned during the period by the maximum offering price per share on the last day of the period.

Credit ratings are assigned by Nationally Recognized Statistical Rating Organizations based on assessment of the credit worthiness of the underlying bond issuers. The ratings range from AAA (highest) to D (lowest) and are subject to change. Not rated indicates the debtor was not rated, and should not be interpreted as indicating low quality. Futures and other derivatives are not eligible for assigned credit ratings by any NRSRO and are excluded from quality allocations.
